MEMORANDUM FOR ALL 152 AW PERSONNEL

SUBJECT: 152 AW Sexual Assault Prevention and Response Policy

- 1. Sexual assault is a criminal offense that has no place in the Nevada Air National Guard. Sexual assault has a negative and lasting impact on victims. It undermines unit cohesion, erodes unit effectiveness, and combats readiness.
- 2. Sexual assault is defined as intentional sexual contact characterized by the use of force, threats, intimidation, or abuse of authority or when the victim does not or cannot consent. As used in the DODI 6495.02, the term includes a broad category of sexual offenses consisting of the following specific UCMJ offenses: rape, sexual assault, aggravated sexual contact, abusive sexual contact, forcible sodomy (forced oral or anal sex), or attempts to commit these offenses.
- 3. Sexual assault is punishable under the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ) and other federal and local civilian laws.
- 4. Any member who is a victim of sexual assault is encouraged to report to the 152 AW SARC or a 152 AW Volunteer Victim Advocate (office located in building 56, room 23, phone number 775-788-4581, 24/7 775-240-5922). The SARC office is open Monday-Friday and the response line is open 24/7 at 775-240-5922. Any member who commits or engages in sexual assault will be subject to the Nevada State Code of Military Justice and/or the UCMJ and/or administrative discipline, which could result in discharge action. Sexual assault will not be tolerated.
- 5. Guidance on sexual assault prevention and response is found in the SAPR AFI 90-6001, 11 October 2018, and DODI 6495.02, 24 May 2017.
